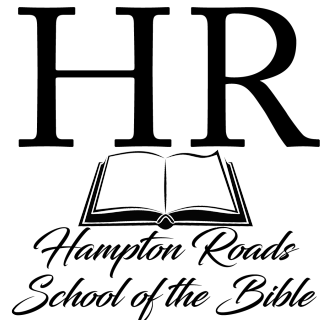


# COURSE SYLLABUS



**Course Title:** Personal Evangelism

**Instructor:** Dr. Philip Harper

**Course Length:** 12 Weeks/ 13 Lessons

**Course Overview:** Personal Evangelism provides practical instruction in witnessing to unbelievers and leading them to Jesus Christ. Emphasis is laid on crucial Bible principles relating to evangelism. Students are taught to use their testimony to witness and present the gospel.

**Course Requirements:** To complete this course, students must: (1) Watch each lesson video, (2) Attempt each lesson quiz, and (3) Submit a lesson summary for each of the 13 lessons.<sup>1</sup> Manually check the completion box after watching the video for each lesson. (See Moodle instruction document under announcements.)

**Course Objectives:** For the student to have an understanding of Biblical principles concerning Personal Evangelism. Students should be able to identify key passages concerning Personal Evangelism and the Gospel. Students should also be able to clearly articulate their personal testimony as well as explain the Gospel using the Word of God.
