Personal Evangelism

Lesson 3 – The Three Soils

Introduction: In this lesson, we will examine the law of sowing and reaping. In Luke chapter 8, the Lord delivers a parable many call the parable of the soils or the parable of the sower. The Lord reveals that we will reap more than we sow. We will receive a harvest later than we sow. And lastly, we will reap what we sow.

The Sower's Hope

There is hope in sowing the Word of God. The Word of God is quick and powerful. The child of God can always sow in hope because of the promise of God's Word.

His To Sow

The sower cast seed with the intent of gleaning a harvest. Sowing the seed is a <u>deliberate</u> action. When the sower went forth, He did so with seed.

- 1. We must have the Word of God with us.
- 2. We <u>must</u> have the power of the Spirit of God with us.

Psalm 126:5-6; Acts 1:8

His To Sow

The more seed that is sown, the more chance there is for a harvest. The soil must be good. Some soil needs to be broken up. (Jeremiah 4:3) The problem is not with the seed but rather the soil. We are commanded to be ready to give every man an answer. (I Peter 3:15)

His _____ In Sowing

After the seed is sown, it is not up to the sower whether or not it will grow. The same seed is sown in every soil. The key to reaping is sowing.
